Contribution: I want to feel and believe I am contributing, that I am not living off a free lunch nor am I a ship passing in the night unnoticed. When I know I am contributing I feel joyful and hopeful.

Without hope life would be painful and a drudgery. Without hope I would be like the school Principal in the story where a grown man says to his mother "I do not want to go to school today for no one likes me and I have no hope." The mother replies "Son, you will have to go for not only are you a responsible person but you are also the Principal."
